

District Software for Personal Computers

*Currently most software is **NOT** licensed to be installed on “personal computers”.*

Here is a list of several software titles that are used on District Owned **Staff** Computers.

Title	Personal Computers for Staff
Adobe Products	Only allowed to install if site has purchased a site licenses.
Microsoft Office	Denied – Microsoft Office is NOT allowed to be installed on any non school board equipment. Users may purchase via “Work at Home” program http://www.broward.k12.fl.us/techstandards/si_software.htm Or, users may download Open Office for free from: http://www.openoffice.org
Apple iWorks	Not Allowed!
Comic Life	Not Allowed!
Filemaker	Not Allowed!
Inspiration/Kidspiration	Allowed
LANDesk	Required – must be downloaded from http://browardlandesk
McAfee	Required – must be download from ETS Service Desk Server/Windows Volume/VirusScan Folder/McAfee Folder
Promethean ActivInspire	Allowed
Promethean Activstudio	Allowed
Smart Notebook Software	Allowed

All software must be removed from a personal computer once the individual is no longer an employee of the School Board of Broward County, Florida. At the time of installation the individual agrees to remove all of the District software when they sign the Personal “Property Release” that is part of the **Personally Owned Device Guidelines**. The tech must have the end user initial the software that has been installed on their personal computer. Attach this worksheet to the Personally Owned Device Guidelines signed document and file at your location.
